



The Nature of Creativity, Action and Service

...if you believe in something, you must not just think or talk or write, but must act. Peterson (2003)

Creativity, action, service (CAS) is at the heart of the Diploma Programme. It is one of the three essential elements in every student's Diploma Programme experience. It involves students in a range of activities alongside their academic studies throughout the Diploma Programme. Each candidate must meet the CAS requirement in addition to the other mandatory components for the award of the diploma. A student's CAS records and self-evaluations must clearly demonstrate quality, balanced content, and commitment for a student to meet the CAS requirement. Failure to meet the requirements will result in no IB diploma being awarded.

The three strands of CAS, which are often interwoven with particular activities, are characterized as follows.

Creativity: arts, and other experiences that involve creative thinking.

Action: physical exertion contributing to a healthy lifestyle, complementing academic work elsewhere in the Diploma Programme.

Service: an unpaid and voluntary exchange that has a learning benefit for the student. The rights, dignity and autonomy of all those involved are respected.

For student development to occur, CAS should involve:

real, purposeful activities, with significant outcomes

personal challenge – tasks must extend the student and be achievable in scope

thoughtful consideration, such as planning, reviewing progress, reporting

reflection on outcomes and personal learning

All proposed CAS activities need to meet these four criteria.

Kreativnost, akcija i društveno korisni rad su sama srž IB programa. Ovaj predmet je jedan od tri suštinska elementa u iskustvu učenika na IB-u. Pored akademskog učenja, učenici su uključeni u razne aktivnosti na CAS-u.

Svi kandidati moraju da ispune CAS zahteve kao dodatak ostalim obaveznim komponentama kako bi stekli diplomu. Beleške studenata o aktivnostima i evaluacije moraju jasno da pokažu kvalitet, uravnoteženost i posvećenost učenika u ispunjavanju CAS zahteva. Ukoliko ne ispunjavaju ove zahteve, učenici ne dobijaju diplomu.

Tri CAS standarda koja su često protkana kroz CAS aktivnosti, se definišu na sledeći način:

KREATIVNOST— umetnost i druga iskustva koja uključuju kreativno razmišljanje.

AKCIJA— fizičke aktivnosti koje doprinose zdravijem životu (sportske aktivnosti) i dopunjuju akademski rad u IB programu.

DRUŠTVENO-KORISNI RAD— neprofitno i dobrovoljno angažovanje učenika koje donosi nova saznanja i iskustva.

Kako bi ovi zahtevi bili ispunjeni, CAS mora biti:

- stvarna, svrshodna aktivnost sa određenim ishodom
- izazov za učenika—aktivnost mora da proširi vidike i bude ostvariva
- promišljena kroz planiranje, praćenje napretka i izveštavanje
- reflektovana kroz ishode i stečeno znanje

Sve predložene CAS aktivnosti moraju da ispune navedene standarde.
