



"Bird will like a purple shirt and skirt," says Turtle.






"Bird will not like this purple shirt and skirt," says Duck. "This shirt and skirt will not fit Bird."

Duck.


"I will hurry and paint the bird home,"



At last, the purple bird home is finished.


"We did it, Turtle," says Duck.


"Bird will like this purple bird home," says Turtle.



Kirk will find out that Sunburst likes to curl up in his lap and be petted. She will purr when Kirk strokes her fur.





## Bertha, the Sales Clerk

Her boss tells her, "Bertha, that is bad service. There is a person needing help at the lumber shop. Try to find a job there."




Bertha has learned a lot. She goes to the lumber shop. Her job is selling lumber, and she does not eat it! Bertha has found the perfect job for her.



# Earth Day




Sherm wants to learn about Earth Day. Sherm asks Pearl about it. Perhaps she will know.








Pearl goes on, "We can gather trash. We can learn how to put it in the right bins and bags. People will make new paper, glass, and cans from the trash we gather."




Pearl goes on, "We can learn to save water. We can learn to turn off lights and turn down heat. This helps the earth."


